Winston, **you'll** now lift the orange bowl please....

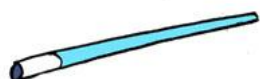
Winston : Oh, **it's** there!

Thank you for your help, Winston!

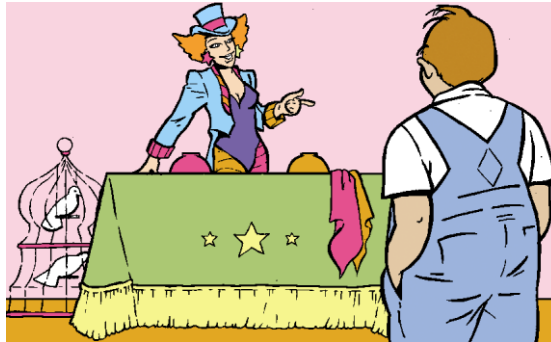
Trisha: Oh oh! Winston! Come back! **You've** forgotten something!

The magic of Tricky Trisha: Problems



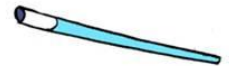
Trisha : Earnest, **you'll** be careful, **won't** you when taking away my equipment?
