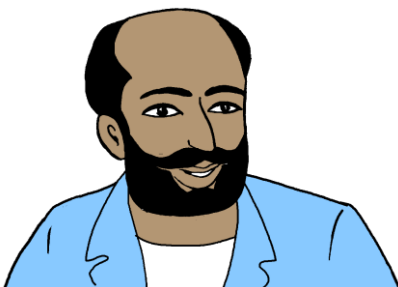


Pat's grocery store : Diet !
